Written procedure No.03, initiated 08.03.2023

1. Description:

The Written procedure for approval of revision of the Guidelines for Pre-defined applicants for the 1st Call for Proposals under the (INTERREG VI-A) IPA Bulgaria Serbia Programme 2021-2027, was initiated by the Head of the Managing Authority and co-chair of the MC on 08.03.2023.

The modification concerns extension of the maximum project duration set out in point 2.5.2.1 of the Guidelines for pre-defined applicants from 24 to 30 months, as well as amendment of point B5.9 (supporting documents parts) where is included opportunity for the beneficiaries to choose among three options for ensuring sufficient information and justification of the efficiency of the planned budget for supply of equipment, namely:

- From "At least 3 official offers from different providers for the envisaged supply (signed by respective provider) - issued in the original language and English translation signed by respective organization as true copy." to "At least 3 official offers from different providers for the envisaged supply (signed by respective provider) OR market research on the basis of company catalogues OR historical data for concluded contracts from previous similar deliveries - issued in the original language and English translation signed by respective organization as true copy."

The official letter No. 99-00-2-60/08.03.2023 with the proposed amendments, was sent to the MC members via e-mail, for review and approval.

The MC members were given **5 working days** to send their approval or comments on the proposed documents. Several opinions of approval were received, as well as with recommendations from the Ministry of Environment and Water (MOEW) concerning ensuring clear demarcation and double financing check in the assessment stage under the Strategic project between both Programmes, as well as proposal for inclusion of the text: "OR market research on the basis of company catalogues OR historical data for concluded contracts from previous similar deliveries" in question 21 of "ADMINISTRATIVE AND ELIGIBILITY COMPLIANCE CHECK" at page 58 of the Guidelines for pre-defined applicants. The above recommendations are summarized in a table and communicated to the MC members for information.

2. Decisions:

Decision 1:

The Monitoring Committee approves the amendment of point 2.5.2.1 of the Guidelines for pre-defined applicants in reference with extension of the maximum project duration.

Decision 2:

The Monitoring Committee approves the amendment of point B5.9 where is included opportunity for the beneficiaries to choose among three options for ensuring sufficient information and justification of the efficiency of the planned budget for supply of equipment, as well as inclusion of the corresponding text on page 58 of the Guidelines for pre-defined applicants in line with the recommendations of the MOEW.

The hereby decision enter into force on 16th March 2023 – the date following the deadline for submission of comments from the MC.
