

# Sixth Strategy Board meeting of the Territorial Strategy under

## Interreg VI-A IPA Bulgaria - Serbia Programme 2021 -2027 held on February 25th, 2025

### 1. Description:

The Strategy Board meeting under Interreg VI-A IPA Bulgaria – Serbia Programme 2021-2027, was held on February 25<sup>th</sup>, 2025 **Online via Webex**, with the following agenda:

- Preparing for the next open call: Conceptual framework for services of general interest:

The following decisions were taken by the Strategy Board:

#### 2. Decisions:

#### **Decision 1:**

The Strategy Board reached the following decisions regarding the key content and eligibility criteria for the upcoming call for the provision of services of general interest:

- The call will not be restricted in scope, allowing opportunities for both the development and piloting of cross-border services.
- A sector-wide approach will be maintained, with no predefined sectoral limitations, except for the exclusion of tourism-related and fire-related activities to prevent double funding and ensure clear demarcation.
- ➤ The infrastructure component of project proposals will remain optional. Consequently, no budget cap will be imposed on investments, ensuring a palanced approach between infrastructure and soft measures.

- Both technological solutions and infrastructure will be equally supported, with neither being prioritized over the other.
- Proposals should focus on developing new services of general interest alongside improvements to existing cross-border services.
- ➤ Each project may involve up to four partners—one lead partner and three project partners. Additionally, each institution may participate in only one project proposal to ensure broader institutional involvement.
- Supporting fewer but larger projects.
- Projects exceeding €500,000 must include more than one pilot action and solution, while those below this threshold should have at least one.
